Update on Moore property.

- Ray had the Moores added as additional insured on festival liability policy.

Ron still waiting for electrical quotes. Need to call PSNH to disconnect power on lower road.
 Rough estimate is probably \$2k or so to do have it established up by school again and able to switch off and on.

Volunteers / Parking

- Beth set up "sign up" program for volunteers. Time slots are now set up for volunteers to sign up online for their shifts. Shifts are set up in 2-hour overlapping time slots to have better coverage and transition time.

- Sunday shifts available 8am-5pm. Info booth 8am-2pm. Booster sales 9am-4pm.
- Monday 9am-3pm unlimited spots for cleanup.
- Beth will check with Ben on hours and ages for volunteers at entertainment stage.
- Need to check on Nichols parking. Kevin Milender owns this now. Kevin sent email to Ray that he was ok to do this, but needs a letter from us.
- Bec to call about Split Rock.
- Need to check on Joppa also.
- Chicken BBQ Bec will ask Adam if we need any volunteers there.
- Proposal to put Knoxland in the field near the old fire station on Kearsarge Mtn Road. Possible parking behind them for crafters since they will only come in and out once.
- Runners and volunteers need their parking passes.
- Billy assigned police officer for Nichols parking area.
- Buses we don't need the short bus, two large should be fine with the main street layout.

Rides

- Scott Miller talked with Ray on Friday. Will get us a contract shortly. Short on kids rides, but if we can flatten some more space next to odd fellows building he thinks he can fit 2 kids rides in. For food, Scott has french fries, fried dough, onion rings.
